Participant Direct Deposit Enrollment Form

The Fund is pleased to be able to offer our participants the convenience of direct deposit. Receive your annual distribution payment quickly and automatically to your checking or savings account.

Why should you consider signing up for direct deposit?

- It saves you trips to your financial institution.
- It eliminates the possibility of lost, stolen or forged checks.
- Your money is deposited faster and reduces the possibility of overdrafts.
- You get your money deposited into your account even if you're on vacation, on tour or away from home for whatever reason.
- Never have to worry about cashing your FMSMF check before the 90-day expiration and avoid any resulting fee that may be required for a check reissue.

To enroll in Full Service Direct Deposit, please complete and sign this form and return it to the Fund at the address listed on the front of this form.

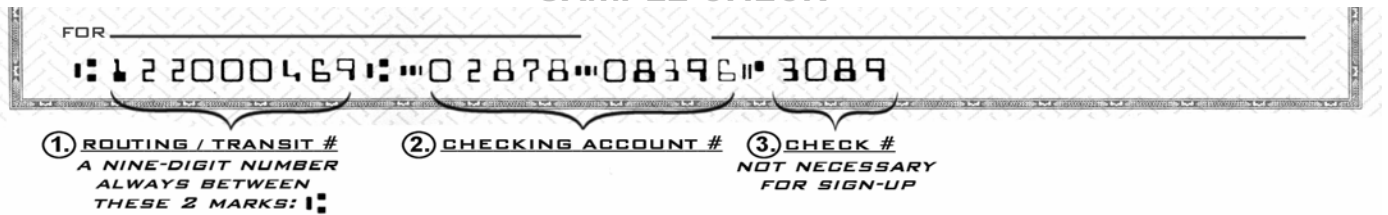
If depositing funds into a savings account, ask your bank to give you the Routing/Transit Number for your account. It is not always the same as the number on a savings deposit slip. This will help ensure that you are credited correctly.

IMPORTANT: If depositing to a checking or money market checking account, you must attach a VOIDED check – NOT a deposit slip.

Currently, direct deposit is ONLY available to U.S.-based financial institutions.

Below is a sample of a check MICR line,
detailing where the necessary information
to complete this form can be found.

SAMPLE CHECK



1. Routing Number

The first number in the MICR line at the bottom of your check is your bank's routing number. It is 9 digits long and always starts with 0, 1, 2 or 3.

2. Account Number

Your account number may appear before or after your check number in your check's MICR line.

3. Check Number

The sequential number for your checks appears in both the MICR line at the bottom of your checks and the upper right corner of your checks. This number allows you to keep track of the checks you write.
